St. Joseph School Dress Code & Uniform Policy

Uniform appearance creates an atmosphere of academic growth, a sense of respect and modesty, and fosters a positive Catholic environment.

Parents are responsible for their child's compliance with the St. Joseph Dress Code/Uniform Policy. The principal will make the final decision as to the appropriateness of uniform, hair, accessories, etc. In the event that a student is out of uniform, the parent will be contacted by the school office, and the parent will need to promptly make arrangements for his/her child to meet the Dress Code requirements.

New Dress Code Policy

Students that are not following the uniform policy will be given a dress code reminder notice. This notice will specifically identify what attire they were wearing that was not in compliance with our dress code. This reminder slip will be sent home for a parent signature to be returned to school the following day.

A student who receives three reminder slips will not be able to participate in the next Friday casual day.

GIRLS' REQUIREMENTS

Shirts/Blouses

Grades 1-8: white, red, or navy blue

Grades 1-5: shirt must be tucked in

Collared blouse, short or long sleeve, turtleneck; no prints, logos, or lace

Jumpers

Grades 1-5 only

The Uniform Place (Belair #83, style Shift) or Land's End (Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid)

Jumpers need to be the appropriate length

Skirts

Grades 6-8 only

The Uniform Place (Belair #83, style Box Pleat) or Land's End (Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid)

Skirts need to be the appropriate length

Pants

Grades 1-8: navy blue, khaki, or black

Solid Twill or corduroy conservative style without extra pockets or decorations

No leggings in place of uniform pants but may be worn under Jumper or Skirt. Leggings may be black or navy blue

Belt

Grades 1-8: brown, black, or navy blue

Belt recommended if needed

Shorts

Grades 1-8: navy blue or khaki

Solid twill conservative style without extra pockets and appropriate length

Optional during August, September, May, & June

Sweatshirt/Fleece

Spirit wear sweatshirt or fleece with "SJS" logo only

No hooded sweatshirt

Sweater

Grades 1-8: white, red, or navy blue

Vest, Cardigan, or long sleeve pullover (V-Neck or crewneck); no prints, logos, or lace

Socks

Grades 1-8: white, red, navy blue, or black

Solid colored knee highs, tights, crew socks or ankle socks

Shoes

Grades K3-8

Closed-toed dress or tennis shoes.

Shoelaces must be tied

No slide on shoes (Crocs), cowboy or fashion boots, sandals, or flip flops

Other

Hair should be neat, clean, and kept out of the eyes

No extreme hairstyles or colors

Jewelry and makeup should not be a distraction

BOYS' REQUIREMENTS

Shirts

Grades 1-8: white, red, or navy blue
Grades 1-5: shirts must be tucked in
Short or long sleeve collared knit dress shirt, turtleneck; no prints or logos

Pants

Solid twill or corduroy conservative style without extra pockets or decorations
Pants must be worn at the waist
Grades 1-8 navy blue, khaki or black

Belt

Grades 1-8: brown, black or navy blue
Belt recommended if needed

Shorts

Grades 1-8: navy blue or khaki
Solid twill conservative style without extra pockets and appropriate length
Optional during August, September, May, & June

Sweatshirt/Fleece

Spirit wear sweatshirt or fleece with "SJS" logo only
No hooded sweatshirt

Sweater

Grades 1-8: white, red, or navy blue
Vest, Cardigan, or long sleeve pullover (V-Neck or crewneck); no prints or logos

Socks

Grades 1-8: white, red, navy blue, or black
Solid colored crew socks or ankle socks

Shoes

Grades K3-8
Closed-toed dress or tennis shoes
Shoelaces must be tied
No slide on shoes (Crocs), sandals, or flip flops

Hair

Hair should be neat, clean, and kept out of eyes
No extreme hairstyles or colors

ALL STUDENTS

Out of Uniform Days

Scout uniforms may be worn on meeting days
Students may not wear casual attire on Mass days unless a Mass day falls on student's birthday
Special days include: student's birthday, last Friday of the month, as announced by Principal, or out of uniform passes (can only be redeemed on Friday's)
School appropriate clothing, which includes jeans (proper fit and no tears, rips, or wear marks), sweatshirts, and T-shirts
NOT ALLOWED: T-shirts with offensive messages/slogans, see-through material, halters, bare midriffs, spaghetti straps

Spirit Wear Day

Spirit wear is allowed with uniform pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers
Any St. Joseph spirit wear is acceptable (Circus shirt, Fractions-in-Actions, Play, etc)

Gym Uniforms

K3-8: must have extra pair of gym shoes just for physical education classes
Grade 4-8: Grey "Property of St. Joseph School" t-shirt, navy blue athletic shorts
